COUNCILLOR AND EMPLOYEE PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

Note:

The GDPR does not directly call out photographs as sensitive personal data, but this does not mean that, when used with other information, they could not constitute this;

- Where photographs of individuals that are uniquely identifiable are used, the St. Asaph City Council will obtain consent for usage (if no other lawful basis for processing are available).
- Photographs should be handled in a similar manner to any other personal data, and the St. Asaph City Council must take appropriate technical measures to protect this data.
- Photographs where individuals are not uniquely identifiable lessens the risks and impacts on data subjects should this data be compromised. Therefore, consent may not be required if this is within the council's legitimate interests (for the public sector this would be the public task basis).
- Non-identifiable group photographs or background photographs may be used without prior consent.
