2. Purpose

3. Proposals

 - Replace Banners on the High Street
 - Finger Signs to: Bowls, Cricket, Football, Library etc
 - New Litter Bin by the BT bench
 - Street Furniture
 - It's Your Neighbourhood:
 - ❖ Planters
 - ❖ Watering Cans
 - ❖ Water Bowser
 - Walking Football:
 - ❖ Kit
 - ❖ Footballs
 - ❖ Training
 - ❖ Winter playing costs
 - Cricket Club also have a project in mind.
 - Allotment Association would like boundary fencing.
- The meeting also discussed the possibility of re-siting the War memorial to the area of the Common near the Doctors' Surgery and creating a Memorial Garden. This would be a larger project than these funds would allow and would be more appropriate to Burbobank or Gwynt y Mor funds. The meeting was keen for the City Council to prepare a City Plan.

The City Council should apply for funds for six flagpoles, new street furniture and signage and banners.
